We meet to Learn, Intercede, have Fellowship and be fuelled for Evangelism

## **4<sup>th</sup> June: Total God : Whole Life Worship – Romans 12:1-8**

How would you describe having 'Whole life Worship'?

Read slowly together, pausing after each sentence to let it sink in: Romans 12:1-8

1. What surprises you?
2. What does the passage say about God's nature?
  - a) What does God seek from us? Is second best ok?
3. What does it say about human nature?
  - a) What does Paul mean by "offer your bodies as a living sacrifice"?
  - b) What is worship that isn't a living sacrifice?
  - c) How does this come about? (v2)
4. What is God saying to you through the passage?
5. How will you live this out this week? – at work, with your family/friends, with those you will meet this week

### **Want to join a LIFE group or MAT?**

LIFE groups are primarily groups that meet in people's homes around the Bible to share life and pray together. MATs meet to ask God what he's calling them to do in an area of Glossop and to act on what he calls them to do.
