Read together: Galatians 5:13-26

1. What surprises you?
2. What does the passage say about God's nature?
 - a) How do we understand God as Spirit?
 - b) What is the Character of the Spirit of God?
 - c) How can we bare His fruit?
3. What does it say about human nature?
 - a) Has God ever been made of 'flesh'?
 - b) How does that change our view of God?
 - c) How does that change our view of the flesh?
 - d) Is Paul saying that 'flesh' is evil or is it the broken desires that come because we are 'flesh'?
 - e) Are we called to be more than just 'felsh'?
4. What is God saying to you through the passage?
 - a) Read out the list of the acts of 'the flesh' v19-21a. Is there a hint of any of these in your life?
 - b) Read out the list of the fruit of the Spirit v22-23a. Is there a fruit you struggle to see in your life, or need to work on? Ask God in the quiet to help you with it?
5. How will you live this out this week? – at work, with your family/friends, with those you will meet this week
