First Aid Training Monday 1 February 7-9.30pm at The Vineyard. This is a certificated course which will cover the essential elements of what to do whilst waiting for an ambulance to arrive. It covers the aims of First Aid, what to put in a First Aid kit, how to deal with an unconscious person, resuscitation, treating burns and bleeding, and what to do if a child suffers from asthma, epilepsy or diabetes. On satisfactory completion of the course, a Basic First Aid Course, with Child Module Certificate will be awarded. This is valid for three years. The course is free. Life Group Notes

Bible Focus:-Mark 12:28-31

1. What do you think of when you hear 'body, mind and spirit'?
2. What other area of ourselves does Jesus mentions in regards to loving God? What does that look like in your life?
3. What does this passage teach us about God? Jesus says to the scribe "You are not far from the kingdom of God". What do you think he meant? What would the scribe have to do to receive the kingdom of God?
4. How do you engage your body in worship? Your mind? Your Spirit? Is there one you engage with more easily? Is God challenging you to exercise the others – go on, ask him?
5. If you were there on Sunday, what surprised you. What was comfortable and what was not comfortable for you in worship?
6. What about those around you at work, on your street, where you spend most of your time? How can you engage your body, mind, spirit and strength in worshipping God through your witness (Christian engagement) with them?
